Grove Road, Wickhambreaux
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2022

To allow overhead structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grove Road, Wickhambreaux.

A closure is planned from 17th January 2022 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 17th January 2022 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS278502AA-03 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Grove Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Chapel Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead structure works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route is via Stourmouth Road, The Street, Preston Lane, Preston Road, The Street, Plucks Gutter, Gore Street, A253 Ramsgate Road, A28 Canterbury Road, Island Road, Grove Ferry Hill and Grove Ferry Road.

Please note, there is an 18 tonne weight limit on Grove Ferry Bridge.

The alternative route for vehicles over 18 tonne is via The Street, Preston Lane, Preston Road, Preston Hill, A257 High Street, Canterbury Road, Wingham Lane, The Street (Ickham), Wickham Lane, Wickham Road, Grove Road and vice versa.
