Stodmarsh Road, Canterbury
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stodmarsh Road, Canterbury.

A closure is planned from 21st January 2022, with estimated completion by 21st January 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SEPOL0000175578ONSA-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stodmarsh Road will be closed from outside Red Ridge to outside Broome Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for through traffic under 6'6" is via Stodmarsh Road, Moat Lane, High Street, King Street, Fordwich Road, A28 Mill Road, Sturry Road, Tourtel Road, Military Road, Broad Street, Lower Bridge Street, A257 St George's Place, Lower Chantry Lane, Longport, St Martin's Hill, Littlebourne Road and vice versa.

Due to the width restriction on Fordwich Road, the alternative route for through traffic wider than 6'6" is via A257 Littlebourne Road, Canterbury Road, The Hill, Jubilee Road, Court Hill, Eldridge Hill, Stodmarsh Road and vice versa.
