(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2023

To allow drainage and carriageway patching works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stodmarsh Road, Wickhambreaux.

A closure is planned from 9th January 2023, with estimated completion by 11th January 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70711308698-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stodmarsh Road will be closed between the junctions with Burnt House Hill and Undertrees Farm Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage and carriageway patching works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Burnt House Hill, Hollybush Lane, Stodmarsh Road and vice versa.
