TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2024

O'Halloran & O'Brien Ltd works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A257 Littlebourne Road, Canterbury.

A closure is planned from 24th July 2024, with estimated completion by 22nd October 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27800014013-02 - O'Halloran & O'Brien Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A257 Littlebourne Road will be closed between the western entrance to St Martin's Hospital and Chaucer House Care Home, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by O'Halloran & O'Brien Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A257 St Martin's Hill, Longport, Lower Chantry Lane, A2050 New Dover Road, Dover Road, Dover Road Slip East On, A2 Dover Road, Barham Slip Eastbound Off, B2046 Box Iron Road, Adisham Road, High Street, A257 Canterbury Road, Wingham Road, High Street, The Hill, Canterbury Road, A257 Littlebourne Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
