TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2024

Openreach works.

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grove Road, Wickhambreaux.

A closure is planned from 10th October 2024, for up to one day, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WF0D625H-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Grove Road will be closed from the junction with Grove Ferry Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Grove Road, The Street, Preston Lane, Preston Road, Preston Hill, A257 High Street, Canterbury Road, Wingham Road, High Street, Nargate Street, Wickham Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
