Openreach works.

To allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grove Road, Wickhambreaux.

A closure is planned from 4th March 2025, with estimated completion by 5th March 2025, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WFTL7T8Y-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Grove Road will be closed in the vicinity of New Grove House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while telegraph pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Grove Road, The Street, Preston Lane, Preston Hill, A257 High Street, Canterbury Road, Wingham Road, High Street, Nargate Street, Wickham Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
