TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2025

Openreach works.

To allow pole testing and tree cutting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grove Road, Preston.

A closure is planned from 29th July 2025, for up to one day, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WG4P1K8L02PTSB-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Grove Road will be closed from the junction with Grove Ferry Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing and tree cutting works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Wickham Road, Nargate Street, A257 High Street, A257 Wingham Road, A257 Canterbury Road, A257 High Street, Preston Hill, Preston Road, Preston Lane, The Street, Grove Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
